Mr. Butz has an 80% service disability from PTSD. He qualifies for a service dog, but training alone costs upward of \$40,000. With our donations we can make this happen for him.

As if the family isn't coping with enough with Mr. Butz's disability, a year or so ago, Teddy, their 3 yr. old was diagnosed with A.L.L. A.L.L. is acute lymphoblast leukemia, a cancer that affects the white blood cells. These cells fight infection and help protect the body against disease. Patients with A.L.L. have too many immature white blood cells in their bone marrow. Mr. & Mrs. Butz have been traveling back and forth from the children's hospital with Teddy for cancer treatments. Medical bills, fuel costs and traveling expenses have become extensive, making it an extremely difficult time for the Butz family.
